# Take the ISWA Program

The self-paced, fully online Industry Skin Wellness Associate (ISWA) Program provides specialized training and an official designation for industry professionals in wound, ostomy and/or continence care. By taking the ISWA program, or sponsoring a representative to take the program, you will be supporting education and training in the field, while gaining recognition, trust, and visibility among healthcare professionals including NSWOCs and SWANs.



# **Program Structure**

Level 1 - Clinical component in Wound, Ostomy, and/or Continence (3 separate modules)
Level one prepares the student to have an enriched understanding of Wound, Ostomy, and
Continence related issues. To complete level 1, students must complete at least one (1) course
(Wound, Ostomy, and /or Continence). Once a student has completed at least one (1) level one
course, they can then take level 2.

#### Level 2 - Advanced component

Addresses:

- o Partnerships with healthcare professionals
- o Product placement
- o Navigating the healthcare system
- o Business plan development

Level two prepares students with an enhanced ability to position their product portfolios from a clinical practice lens and to provide optimal support for nurses caring for those with wound, ostomy, and continence issues. Level two is designed to provide industry partners the enhanced ability to work collaboratively with healthcare professionals and to be ambassadors for the ethical partnerships with industry.

Upon completion of level two graduates will be eligible to use the ISWA designation. Designation is dependent on the number of courses completed:

ISWA-O (Ostomy module)
ISWA-C (Continence module)
ISWA-W (Wound module)
Or a combination such as: ISWA-OC, ISWA-OCW, etc.

# **Webinar Series**

The NSWOCC WOC Institute hosts a series of 1-hour educational webinars on Zoom for NSWOCs, SWANs, and allied healthcare professionals throughout the year, excluding summer months.

Partnering with NSWOCC to host an educational webinar gives you the chance to choose your own speaker to present your wound, ostomy, and/or continence products or services while educating and interacting with attendees directly through Q&A sessions.

NSWOCC collaborates with partners to create marketing materials, promote the event, and manage logistics, including moderating and issuing certificates, and providing you with post-webinar attendance reports.

All webinars must be booked a minimum of 28 days in advance through the NSWOCC website. When you book a webinar, you will reserve a full week block. This will ensure that other webinars will not be booked right before/ after your webinar date or oversaturate our educational calendar.
